The Mayor and Town Council of the Town of Jena, Louisiana, met in regular session on Monday, July 3, 2023, at 9:00 a.m. at their regular meeting place, the Town Hall.

Mayor LaDawn C. Edwards called the meeting to order; Councilman David Paul Jones opened the meeting with prayer and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Mr. Sandifer made a motion seconded by Mr. Francis to adopt a resolution to award the Roadway Improvements-FY 2022 LCDBG No. 2000727470 Project to the low bidder, D&J Construction Company, LLC, and authorize Mayor Edwards to execute all documents related to the project. Motion unanimously approved.

Mr. Richardson made a motion seconded by Mr. Jones to approve the Independence Day holiday to begin July 3, 2023, at 12 noon. Motion unanimously approved.

Firefighter Jeffery Benson presented the Fire Report.

Superintendent Ronny Steele presented the utility report.
